

SENIOR GRAND PRIX RULES

1. A player must be a current member of the USTA.
2. The top EIGHT qualified and available point earners in each singles division and the top FOUR qualified and available teams in each doubles division will be eligible for the Championship.
3. To qualify for SINGLES, a player must compete in a minimum of FOUR SCTA sanctioned tournaments (or 1/3 of all tournaments) in his/her age division. To qualify for DOUBLES, a team must compete in a minimum of TWO SCTA sanctioned tournaments (or 1/3 of all tournaments) in the same age division.
4. A player may qualify in several age divisions, but may enter only ONE singles and ONE doubles event in the Championship. The Tournament Committee reserves the right to offer Wild Cards to players who are one tournament short of the minimum qualification. Wild Cards may be given in events that are not filled by qualified players.
5. Points will be awarded based on draw size and round reached. However, all players will receive five (5) participation points.
6. If a player fails to play a tournament to completion, for any reason, or is defaulted by the referee, he will receive no points for that tournament, and the tournament will not count as a tournament played.
7. At the end of the season, if players are tied for eighth place (or fourth place in doubles), with an equal number of points earned, the player or team who competed in more tournaments will be invited to the Championship. If both points and number of tournaments are equal, a play-off will be held prior to the start of the Championships to determine which player will be placed in the draw.
8. Players who accept an invitation to participate in the Championship agree to play the event to completion, including any consolations or playoffs that may be offered.
9. The 2017 SCTA Senior Grand Prix season includes all SCTA sanctioned tournaments from November 1, 2016 through October 31, 2017.
10. Results of the 2017 SCTA Senior Grand Prix Championship, held in December 2017, will count for 2017 ranking.
