The USTA Southern California continues with its Section-wide Captain Appreciation and Recognition program. An Area League Coordinator may nominate up to four captains for the Area Captain of the Year Award. The Adult Selection Committee will select an Area Winner from among the nominees. Winning Captains will be notified by the Section and their Area League Coordinator.

Each Area's winning captain will be a finalist nominee for the **Southern California Captain of the Year Award**. All finalist nominees and a guest will be invited to attend a celebratory luncheon that will be held in the first quarter of each year, along with their Area League Coordinators and the Adult Selection Committee. Each finalist nominee will be individually recognized after which the **Southern California Captain of the Year** will be announced. The winner will receive an award, a gift card and be recognized in the various USTA Southern California print and electronic media.

Key attributes that the selection committee will be considering when selecting an Area Captain winner and ultimately the **Southern California Captain of the Year** winner include:

- Exhibits a high level of sportsmanship
- Displays leadership and organizational skills both on and off the court
- Mentors other captains and players
- Treats teammates with respect
- Takes responsibility for his or her actions
